Queen Elizabeth Robson was the first white girl born at Manson. Queen Elizabeth was crowned by Benton Bangs, who dropped the crown as he was placing it on her head. Due to the depression, Wenatchee did not have a festival, and Manson's royal court made their own dresses in high school sewing class. Queen Elizabeth's crown was also made from the same material as the dress. Manson's festivities included an afternoon coronation and evening dance.
